International Education Programs and Scholarships

IELTS and TOEFL certificates have expanded the educational opportunities for Uzbek youth in the best universities worldwide. Educational programs like Erasmus Mundus, Fulbright, and Chevening offer substantial scholarships to young people. The success of Uzbek youth in these programs is closely tied to their proficiency in English. Over the past five years, 127 Uzbek students have secured Erasmus Mundus grants. Between 2015-2020, 84 students received grants, and in the 2021-2024 period, 43 more students have benefited from these opportunities. Additionally, in the Fulbright program, 88 Uzbek students have been awarded scholarships in the last five years.
